Dear friends,

The end of a year is usually an opportunity to realise and evaluate how we used the time given to move forward. For us, the 2016 was very unique due to several events that happened in the Czech Republic and in India.

During the 15th year of our Festival ProTibet, we welcomed Mr Thubten Wangchen, the member of the Central Tibetan Administration. He was pleased to see that Czech citizens show the solidarity with Tibet not only on the occasion of hanging the Tibetan flag on 10th of March, but also during the visit of the Chinese president.

Usually, another important matter for us is visiting and checking all supported places in the northern India. During six weeks, our young coordinators covered around 3,000 km on dusty roads to meet personally all the people supported, "higher authorities" and partners engaged in our projects.

But the most significant milestone was exceeding CZK 20 millions (EUR 750,000) forwarded to the supported ones. We would like to point out this special moment mostly because that it is almost unbelievable how many people decided to give their time, energy, ideas and finance to support particular Tibetans on the other side of the world. All such decisions lead to providing the biggest Czech developing aid to support

the Tibetans. These are the causes of changes in lives not only of the needed, but also, as we hope, in lives of the supporters, because without their help we would not be able to do the MOST Pro Tibet.





SPONSORSHIP PROTIBET - CHILDREN



Total amount 90,159.1 EUR

451 monks, nuns and children

The objective of our project is to improve the basic living conditions and to provide a quality education for Tibetan children, monks and nuns. Altogether, we support children in eight grammar and monastic schools in the Northern India and Tibet

In schools of Tibetan Homes Foundation (India), Tibetan Children's Village (India) and Gyalten (Tibet), 237 children are being educated.

214 monks and nuns from Ladakh and Spiti study Buddhist philosophy and other traditional and also modern subjects.

"I've got another letter from sponsored monk Tenzin. He writes about his good study result and also that he likes football. It's perfect to have somebody who appreciate us, no matter distance, culture or language." Pavel (In August 2016, he met monk Tenzin sponsored by him.)

107 Elderly Tibetans

The stories of those Tibetan people we support are similar in many ways. In their youth, they fled from Tibet to the exile in India and now, at the advanced age, they are not able to take care of themselves.

"After the escape, my first destination was a small town of Menchuka. Here I served in an Indian army for a while. After the army service I moved again, this time to the very North of India, to the Himalayan Ladakh. I made my living as a road builder. Here I met my wife Kungsang Dolma. After our marriage, we moved to the region of Byllakuppe in the Southern India and we worked in agriculture." (Phuntsok – on the picture)

We take care of seniors in exile villages of Ladakh, homes for elderly people in Mussorie and Rajpur (Tibetan Homes Foundation) and last, but not least, in homes in Byllakuppe and Chauntra (Central Tibetan Administration).

Daily schedule of seniors in Chauntra

5 am | waking up, a morning tea

and a walk 6 am meditation

7 am a breakfast and a tea

afternoon garden, walks and meditations

6 pm dinner

evening community talks, activities

Every year, March is the month of our Festival ProTibet. During events covered by Festival, we inform about the Tibetan situation and issues and we introduce Tibetan culture. In 2016, the main topic for our festival were elderly people and after the festival, more than 3,701 EUR left to India for Tibetan grandmothers and grandfathers. Also, we started cooperation with the home for elderly people Chauntra.

GOAT PROTIBET



120 goats

In 2016, we gave **120 goats** to 12 families from the village of Henle and we bought fodder for winter. Thanks to the cattle the nomads have enough food for their families.

Which families were chosen?

"Mr Tsering takes care of his 12-members family. He has 9 children and he wants all of them to attend a school. He also takes care of his 86-years old mother who cannot walk "

"Mr Tsedup is 64-years old and looks after another 3 members of his family. His wife died from TBC and his daughter suffers from hepatitis B. Until now, he hasn't got almost any cattle."

"Ms Dolma is 50-years old and because she's got almost no cattle, she works on roads to be able to support her son."

The summer months are spent in India. We find out news to our projects, make photographs of children and seniors enlisted in our Sponsorship, we meet with representatives of institutions, choose products to our e-shop, we film a spot and a documentary about nuns. Also this is the beginning of our sponsorship of nuns from Pin Valley. The financial support will help them to buy fuel wood for winter.

HEALTH CARE



Medical aid, prevention, log wood

Wheelchair ProTibet

Thanks to our project "Wheelchair" we provided **5 wheelchairs**, **4 pairs of walking sticks**, **3 toilet chairs and 2 walking frames**. Medical aid will help to the people in the Tibetan exile villages in Ladakh in their common lives.

Doctors ProTibet

Project focused on illness prevention. In 2016 we contributed to vaccinations against hepatitis B. At this moment this desease is a serious problem in Spiti Valley and Sapan Foundation is our partner in project realisation there.

Log wood for winter

During the freezing Ladakh winter, 17 households were comfortably heated. The most needed elderly people from the exile dormitories in Ladakh were given log wood for winter. The average age of the supported is 78,5.

1,431 EUR in cooperation with Central Tibetan Administration for developing projects focused on health, specifically on medical aids for elderly people and preventive vaccinations of children



1,431 EUR for school Gyalten, Tibet. At this school, a canteen and a sewerage are currently under a reconstruction. The next step planned is to provide heating in the classrooms.



1,431 EUR. It's become a tradition that funds collected through Club help us to run activities connected with promoting the Tibetan culture in the Czech Republic, especially Festival ProTibet.

A group of travellers decided to make a trip to the Himalayas. They trekked through Ladakh and Spiti. This journey was dedicated to a great purpose. They decided to use the proceed as a support to the education of children in Demul village.


Cooperation

Funds consist of donations within the projects Sponsorship, Goat ProTibet and School ProTibet and another one-off gifts in the amount of 40,507.06 EUR are going to be transfered to India and Tibet in 2017 and also from the amount of 16,822.1 from donations to operation organization (which will be used to cover the costs of the main activities in the coming years).
