

EDUCATING CHILDREN IN ADOPTION PROTIBET

TOTAL 81 206 EUR

All children deserve a quality education, a full belly, a soft place to sleep and kind people around them. That's exactly what we're trying to do in the biggest project - Adoption ProTibet. The money from the project goes to monastery schools and SOS Tibetan exile villages, where thousands of children live without parents.

Monastic schools full of monks and nuns received 40 400 EUR from us. We supported the Diskit Monastery with the amount of 3 719 EUR. 5 058 EUR went to the Kowang monastic school for girls. Komik monastery in Spiti and Rangri monastery in Manali, where monks continue their studies, received 9 695 EUR. We sent the amount of 5 058 EUR to the girls' monastery in the remote Pin Valley. One of the longest-supported monasteries, Ki, received 16 870 EUR from us.

40 805 EUR went to SOS Tibetan exile villages. The children who live in them don't have much. But thanks to your support, they have the chance of getting quality education, fun afterschool activities, good food, clothes and ever-improving health care. That's quite something!

We supported the Tibetan Homes Foundation (THF), with 1 500 resident children, with the amount of 34 482 EUR. Tibetan Children Village (TCV) received 6 323 EUR from us.

We are especially happy for the children from THF, who are improving year after year and are regularly ranked among the best students in the entire state of Uttrakhand. The best students continue their education jurney at universities. Miss Choelsum was particularly successful, winning a scholarship to one of the most prestigious medical universities in all of India.









FIRST OF ALL EDUCATION - SCHOOL PROTIBET

TOTAL 12 766 EUR

Educating children is a major tool of eradicating poverty and developing communities. We consider it essential that all children have access to education, even in the winter months or in remote areas of the Himalayas. Thanks to the School ProTibet project, children have school supplies, classroom equipment and also good teachers.

Funds collected in the project of 12 766 EUR were distributed among several places in India and Tibet. Nomadic children living in the highlands of Ladakh received 2 900 EUR for their three-month study program. With this money, we also bought them a new generator and projector. The Bathang school in Tibet received 4 508 EUR from us. Children in elementary school in Bylakuppe were provided with the amount of 2 708 EUR. We supported young female students from a poor farming family with the amount of 966 EUR as a university scholarship. Young and promising THF students received 1 686 EUR in scholarships for universities.











AGING WITH DIGNITY - SUPPORTING SENIORS





Winters in Ladakh bring even -30°C frosts. It doesn't get much warmer in cottages without heating and these are not ideal conditions for old age. Thanks to the **Warmth ProTibet** project, seniors in Ladakh can stay warm.

Wood and dried dung were purchased for the exile camps for 3 416 EUR. Through **Adoption ProTibet**, we supported these seniors with the amount of 6 372 EUR.

We also supported several Homes for Tibetan Seniors in India. We are doing our best to improve the living conditions and peaceful aging with dignity for these people, who have often had a very difficult life. As part of Adoption ProTibet, another 11 592 EUR was distributed between these institutions.

We supported seniors living in the Old people's home under THF near the city of Dehradun with the amount of 6 323 EUR. Seniors in South India have received 1 475 EUR. Seniors living in Chauntra were provided with 3 794 EUR.

In addition, the home for Tibetan seniors in THF in Rajpur was in dire need of repairing waste and water systems. We supported these repairs with the amount of 1 767 EUR as part of the **Water ProTibet** project.





Nomads are absolutely dependent on their herds. Most of them are illiterate, unable to support themselves in the city. They live high in the mountains in unimaginably harsh conditions and everything they own fits in one tent. They only need a community and a herd of goats to survive.

But the winters in Changtang are becoming more and more harsh, the herds are starving and dying. And if there are no goats, there are

no nomads. In 2022, we supported them with the amount of 14 752 EUR.











We had two big goal in 2022. Two expensive operations that should have saved lives. In total, we provided 16 433 EUR for procedures and subsequent treatment.

We donated 9 818 EUR to the successful kidney surgery of the young nun Pema Chogye from the nunnery in the Pin Valley. **The surgery saved her life.**

Three-year-old Sonam from the village of Tuting received 6 614 EUR from us for a heart surgery that was supposed to save her life. After several examinations and a lot of travel worth 1 429 EUR, it was unfortunately discovered that little Sonam's heart is too weak for surgery and no further treatment is possible. The rest of the amount went to the health care account of the Central Tibetan Administration and will be used for other urgent cases. We are very sorry.







GENERAL DONATIONS FOR URGENT CASES



TOTAL 10 075 EUR

General donations are used for the most urgent cases of requests for support, or where there is not enough funding from development projects. We sent a beautiful 10 075 EUR to India in 2022.

The nuns from the Kowang monastery received 8 388 EUR for the purchase of a new, high-quality generator. Thanks to that, they can study in the light when there is no electricity and, if necessary, stay in the monastery even through the winter.

The elders of the Tibetan old people's home in Chauntra needed new safe and working windows. We supported their exchange with the amount of 1 686 EUR.







TOGETHER IN THE CLUB PROTIBET

Long-term regular support of any amount - that is the ProTibet Club.

TOTAL 4 145 EUR

Those who like our activities and want to contribute to what is most important, become supporters of the ProTibet Club. They can contribute, for example, 5 EUR per month. Of the total amount, two-thirds of the proceeds go to India or Tibet for current needs and one third remains in the Czech Republic.

In 2022, Club members supported projects with a total of 4 145 EUR.

We divided this amount into thirds among the costs for a kidney surgery for a young nun from PIN Monastery Pema Chogye. The second part of the money helped the smartest students from THF to continue their studies at universities. And the last part was dedicated to spreading information about the situation in Tibet, organizing the Festival ProTibet and overall patronage of development projects in Tibet and India from the Czech Republic.



KNOWLEDGE AND CULTURE ON FESTIVAL PROTIBET

The ProTibet 2022 festival aimed to describe the situation after the Summer Olympics in China, the unfulfilled promises of the Communist Party, to the 166 sacrificed lives of Tibetans, to the ever-increasing repressions against minorities and, above all, to the fact that despite all this, China held another, this time, Winter Olympic Games. People in Ostrava had the opportunity to enjoy the theatre performance of Forbidden Land, to learn at the public talks Blood, Tears and Medals, Leaving Fear Behind or Living Torches. Club Atlantik was filled with a talk by young climbers about the ascent to the 8,000-meter Gasherbrum II and the painting of the Tibetan and Ukrainian flags on Masaryk Square just peaked the festival beautifully.

We participated in the International Mountaineering Film Festival or the Evolution festival in the summer. We continued with the Obzory travel festival or the Health and Soul festival in Ostrava in autumn. We also took part in the Ostrava Farmers' Market. Traditionally, a charity pre-Christmas sale took place in Arkády Pankrác and now also in Westfield Chodov in Prague.

The funds are, on the one hand, donations received as part of the Adoption ProTibet project and other one-time donations for projects in the amount of EUR 120 090, which will be transferred to India and Tibet in 2023, as well as donations for the operation of the organization in the amount of EUR 13 499, which will be used for covering the costs of the main activity in the following years.
